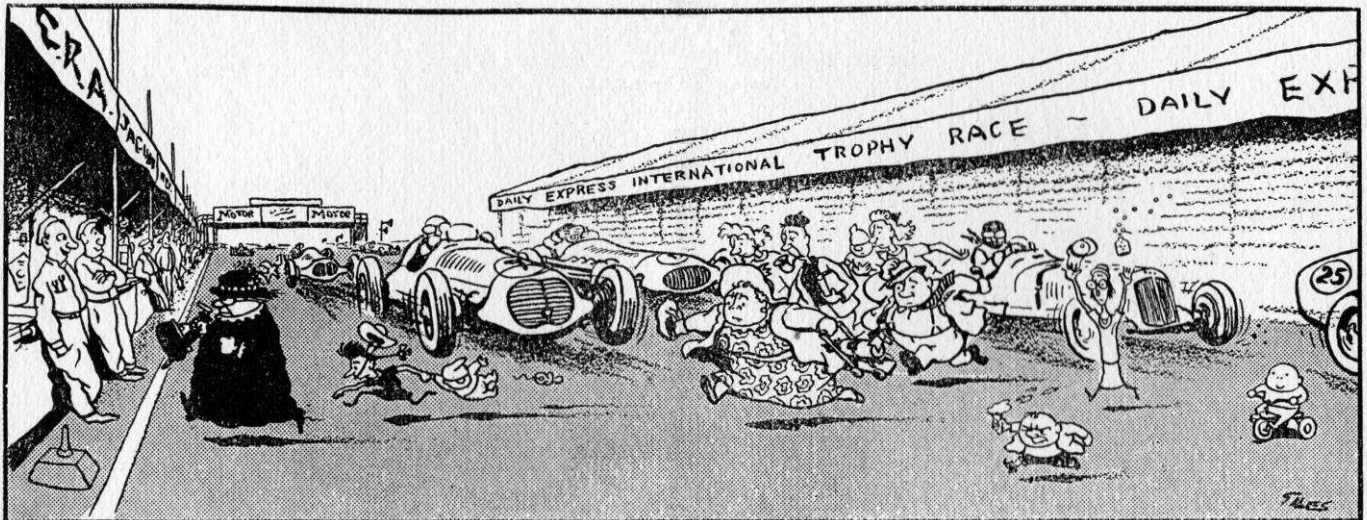


# RONALD (CARL) GILES

1916 – 1995



“ Reckon they ought to put some pedestrian crossings here, eh, lady ? ”

The famous cartoonist who worked for The Daily Express newspaper, making his debut in October 1943. He was an amateur racing driver, driving his XK 120 and a keen observer of motoring events. The above cartoon is an illustration from the menu of the BRDC Annual Dinner for 1949. Giles was a member of the BRDC in the 40's and 50's.
