George Holdcroft was the artist/designer who worked for Royal Doulton responsible for the Motoring Seriesware. This china started in 1906 and consisted of a large range of plates, bowls, tankards, jugs, pitchers, tobacco jar, spittoon etc, in fact everything except cups and saucers! There are six plates with different designs – Blood Money, Deaf, Itch Yer on Govenor, Nerve Tonic, Room for One. The plate without a title pictures a yokel outside a country inn. Besides these six plate designs there are other images on the non-plates such as After The Run. Original designs in pen and ink on tracing paper exist.
